## LAST MINUTE SPRING HOME MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST

*Get your spring checklist ticked before the arrival of the hot weather*

After a delayed spring, the Okanagan is finally revelling in the beauty and freshness of spring. The truncated season means that soon summer will be here, bringing with it holidays, visitors and hot weather. It's a good idea to finish up your spring home maintenance before the temperatures climb, or you are busy taking camping trips or hosting company.

✓ If you've ever tried to clean out your gutters on a scalding, hot roof you know that it is better to attack this chore now. Clean out any leftover fall debris and the winter sediment that can build up. While you're up there, inspect your roof for any needed repairs.

✓ Inspect the wood decks, steps and railings to find any rot that may have set in over the winter months. Find any soft or splintered boards before BBQ and patio party season kicks off.

✓ You will also want to inspect all the exterior wooden windowsills and

siding to check for any chips or winter damage. It may be a good time to do any paint touch-ups and repairs. Look for any holes in exterior brick as well.

✓ Remove any mildew or mould from decks, patios and exteriors with a pressure washer to avoid further rot.

✓ Make sure that the foundation of your home is in solid shape. Patch any cracks with silicone or caulking to avoid further problems.

✓ Service your air conditioning unit before its workload increases to ensure it doesn't have issues when you need it most.

✓ Fix any screens so that you can open your windows to the fresh air without worrying about uninvited pests finding their way in.

✓ Cut back any trees or shrubs that may be encroaching on your house before the growing season.
